## Message from Trustees' desk

On Feb 26th 2010, Iksha foundation started its journey with the vision to provide aid to children suffering from Retinoblastoma (eye cancer) and to create awareness. We at Iksha believe that no child should ever lose eyesight or face death to this type of childhood cancer that has one of the best cure rates.

We started working with doctors at Narayana Nethralaya and Mazumdar Shaw Cancer Research Institute. The support from the doctors, donors, friends and family has been overwhelming. All of it is worthwhile when we see the smiles on the faces of the children who battle the odds and overcome the cancer with a smile.

In 2016-17 year, we collaborated with three new hospitals.

- Eye hospitals- Prabha eye clinic, Vittal eye clinic
- Cancer Hospitals- Sri Shankara Cancer Hospital

We plan to network with more hospitals outside of Bengaluru. We are looking to work with government hospitals to spread the awareness about Retinoblastoma among the health care workers.

A few words from Sidharaju (F/o Padmesh) "My son was only 2 months old when he was diagnosed with eye cancer. We were devastated.

Now, he is 6 years-old and a happy school going child like others of his age. This was possible only with help of Iksha foundation."



On April 16, Rehan had his Enucleation Under Anesthesia and Custom made Ocular Prosthetics(COP) fitted. Later the child re-visited for dermis craft. Rehan, was examined under anesthesia. The subsequent treatment plan was evolved after detailed evaluation.

Uttam Naik was diagnosed with bilateral retinoblastoma at the age of 2 with RE group "D" and LE group "B". The child was advised 6 cycles of chemo and focal laser every 3-4 weeks. His right eye was enucleated of advanced tumor.

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

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


